Student Right-To-Know

Student completion & graduation rates are published annually in the FFCU *Academic Catalog*. In compliance with the Student-Right-to-Know Act of 1991, FFCU reports the following graduation and retention rates.

Retention Rates for First-Time Students Pursuing Bachelor's Degrees = 33%

Retention rates measure the percentage of first-time full-time students who are seeking bachelor's degrees who return to the institution to continue their studies the following fall. It does not include student who have transferred in from other institutions or part-time students. The rate is the percentage of first-time, full-time students who began studies in Fall 2017 and returned in Fall 2018.

Overall Graduation Rate = 55%

Known as the "Student Right to Know" or IPEDS graduation rate, this rate tracks the progress of students who began their studies as full-time, first-time degree- or certificate-seeking students to see if they complete an academic program within 150% of "normal time." This rate is a 4 year average of the rates from 2009 to 2012.

Overall Transfer-Out Rate = 9%

FFU also reports a transfer-out rate, which is the percent-age of the full-time, first-time students who transferred to another institution. (Note: not all students at the institution are tracked for these rates. Students who have already attended another postsecondary institution, or who began their studies on a part-time basis, are not tracked for this rate.)
